- The tuition fee includes all tuition, subject costs (except those listed below), locker hire, insurance, resources and compulsory religious retreats for Years 7-12.
- The annual statement of the family account is issued in February of each year.
- Education Perfect includes online homework for Maths, Science and English.
- The lock fee contributes towards the supply and maintenance of student padlocks.
- The bus fee contributes towards the transportation of students to a variety of school events including, Masses, Retreats, House events, and PE lessons.
- The Payment Option section (refer page 4) and the College's Fees Policy (see *School Fee Accounts*) provide a breakdown of options available to families for the payment of Tuition Fees, Levies and Annual Fee Per Family. **All Year 12 fees, levies and charges must be paid in full by the end of Term 3 (23 September 2022).**
- Subject levies are charged to offset the additional expense and resource-heavy nature of specific subjects, such as Art, Materials Design and Technology, Outdoor Ed, Food Technology, Photography etc. **The elective subjects offered are subject to change at any time.**
- Any students transferring into or out of an elective subject **before** the School Curriculum and Standards Authority deadline in Semester 1 or 2, will incur charges of, or be refunded 100% of the subject cost, whichever is applicable.

Families with more than one child at the College receive discounts on tuition fees, per annum, as outlined below:

- All students and families are eligible for sibling discounts including families who receive automatic tuition fee discounts as holders of eligible means tested family concession cards.
- Any applicable discounts for multiple children will be applied to the child in the lowest year level.



SPLIT BILLING

Families who wish to split their account equally between two parties must provide written advice to the College, **signed by both parties**, authorising the account to be divided equally. The authority is available upon request and should be returned to the Finance Office by **Friday, 11 March 2022**. Please refer to the **Fees Policy** for further information.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Option 1

Payment of all fees, levies and charges in FULL in one instalment by **15 April 2022**. This option is available via direct debit or creditcard. Alternatively, payment may be made by cash, cheque or by direct deposit into the College bank account.

Option 2

Payment of fees, levies and charges in three (3) equal instalments, due on **16 March, 16 June and 16 September 2022**. This option is available via direct debit from bank accounts using the Direct Debit Scheme or by providing the College with your credit card details for automatic payment on the dates specified. In addition, payment may be made by cash.

Option 3

Payment of fees, levies and charges in nine (9) equal instalments, due on the **16 March 2022 and 16th each month thereafter through to 16th November 2022**. This option is only available via Direct Debit from bank accounts using the Direct Debit Scheme or by providing the College with your credit card details for automatic payment on dates specified.

Option 4

Payment of fees, levies and charges in eighteen (18) equal instalments, due on **16 March 2022 and fortnightly thereafter through to 9 November 2022**. This option is only available via direct debit from bank accounts using the Direct Debit Scheme or by providing the College with your credit card details for automatic payment on dates specified.

Option 5

Payment of fees, levies and charges in thirty-six (36) equal weekly instalments, due on **16 March 2022 and weekly thereafter through to 16 November 2022**. This option is ONLY available via direct debit payment plan.

All Year 12 fees must be paid in full by the end of Term 3 (23 September 2022). Contact must be made with the College Business Manager to vary the payment method. Fee concessions may be provided to parents/guardians showing evidence of financial hardship to the Principal.

HEALTH CARE CARD SCHEME

The discounted tuition of \$1,500 covers tuition fees and additional levies and charges (e.g. ICT Levy, subject levies etc.). It does not include additional charges on a user-pays basis (e.g. VET courses, Education Perfect, HPE Workbook, Lock Fee, Bus Levy, P&C Levy, Voluntary Building Fund donation, camps, book hire, excursions, etc.). The discounted Compulsory Building Levy amount is \$300. To access the Health Care Card Tuition Fees Discount Scheme:

- Parents/Guardians will need to show a valid Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card.
- Holders of cards that are due to expire prior to the end of Term 3 will need to show their new card once issued for the discounts to continue.
